All ATMs, Cash Deposit Machines and any other machines used for receipt and payment of cash will remain closed on 10th November 2016. We shall operationalize ATMs in accordance with RBI's directives. We are taking every possible effort to ensure that customers are least inconvenienced. Business hours on 10th and 11th November 2016 has been extended upto 6.00 PM. Further, branches will be open on 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> of Nov'2016 as regular working days for transacting all business. Customers are requested to make best use of the opportunity to deposit recalled notes of Rs. 500 / Rs.1000 denominations in their own accounts. There is no limit for deposit in the account.

We request all our esteemed customers to cooperate with us.

You may get fake phone calls or emails or SMS informing that your account has been blocked along with debit card and asking for sharing card or account details on the above pretext. Please do not give away these details and contact the bank in case of any clarifications.
