# Krishna row: A.P. agrees to Ministry's request

Stalemate on the Nagarjuna Sagar Project site continues; Andhra Pradesh government took possession of project territory a couple of days ago; Union Ministry of Jal Sakti asks A.P. to stop water release till the Krishna River Management Board takes a decision on its indent

ith the stalemate on the Nagarjuna Sagar Project (NSP) site continuing, the Andhra Pradesh government has agreed to two requests made by the Union Ministry of Jal Sakti (MoJS) to stop water release till the Krishna River Management Board (KRMB) takes a decision on the indent placed by Andhra Pradesh on December 4 and the proposal to meet on December 6 at Delhi to discuss all the issues.

The decisions were taken in a virtual meeting held by Debashree Mukherji, Secretary, MoJS, on Saturday with the Chief Secretaries of Andhra Pradesh and Telangana for resolving the dispute over the sharing of Krishna river waters, in the wake of the Andhra Pradesh government taking possession of its 'legitimate' territory on the NSP, a couple of days

From Andhra Pradesh, Chief Secretary K.S. Jawahar Reddy attended the meet whereas his Telangana counterpart was not

Mr. Jawahar Reddy explained in detail the issue and the use of water at the Srisailam Project for power production by Telangana and collecting the same at the NSP so as to maintain complete control of water releases from the NSP on both sides to their advantage, denying the legiti-

mate agreed share of water to Andhra Pradesh.

The Chief Secretary explained the historic injustice done to Andhra Pradesh, as the control of facilities on the left bank in the Srisailam Project was taken over by Telangana although the Srisailam Project is supposed to be under the control of the Chief Engineer, Kurnool, Andhra Pradesh.

He said that the State government had requested Telangana for release of water through the right main canal which caters to the exclusive needs of Andhra Pradesh.

Mala fide intentions

Mr. Jawahar Reddy said that Telangana has mala fide intentions to draw water exclusively for power generation through the left power house of Srisailam without proper indent and release orders to store the same in the NSP wherein they have full control of all the off-takes and this does facilitate required build up level in Srisailam, for A.P. to draw water.

He said the control of the facilities located on the right bank in A.P. territory was taken, adding it will be operated as per the release orders of the KRMB from time to time.

It has been clarified that the A.P. government has issued orders expressing its willingness to hand over the control of identified off-takes to KRMB, whereas Telangana refused to do so.

An indent is placed for release of 5 tmcft of water from the legally agreed allocated share of Andhra Pradesh through the Right Main Canal of the NSP to meet the exigency of drinking water needs.

Meanwhile, the dam site looks like a war zone with heavy deployment of security forces by Andhra Pradesh and Telangana, and the situation continues to remain tense.

The Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) has also been present.

## Criticism of police unfair, says Pinarayi

Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan has described the criticism from certain quarters of the Kerala Police in connection with the ongoing investigation into the recent kidnapping of a child at Kollam as "unfair and unwarranted."

Addressing the media during the Cabinet outreach programme Navakerala Sadas in Palakkad on Saturday, Mr. Vijayan said the State police had risen up to their name in the investigation. He warned that unwarranted criticism

would demoralise the force. The Chief Minister cited several cases as examples to prove the State police's excellence. He pointed out cases such as the murder of a migrant worker's minor daughter at Aluva, the attack on AKG Centre in Thiruvananthapuram, the attack on the ashram of Swami Sandeepananda Giri in Thiruvananthapuram, the notorious Elanthoor human sacrifice, and the train ar-

son attack case at Elathur. "Our police could fetch maximum punishment for the accused in the Aluva

child murder case within

110 days after the crime. The Sangh Parivar had spread rumours that Sandeepananda Giri himself had attacked his ashram. Finally, the police caught the culprits when they arrested some Sangh Parivar men, including a BJP councillor," said Mr. Vijayan. The Chief Minister
