


Jagrukta Devi & the Online Shopping Racket






Masoom Maqsood & his Fake Online Job

Hoshiyaar Singh is sitting in the room with his uncle, Shatir Singh. Suddenly, Hoshiyaar receives a call from an unknown number.



Uncle, do you know any Pappu?


Pappu? Doesn't ring a bell. Why?


