

Beware of fake Valentine's day offers

Ahead of Valentine's day celebrations on 14th February, cyber fraudsters are using the brand names of big companies and tempting customers through fake offers and gifts.

- Messages/ pop-ups/ emails claiming to be from reputed brands/ restaurants are received by victims
- Cyber fraudsters use online platforms to tempt people into clicking these malicious links through brand new offers and gifts.
- Once victim's click on the pop-up messages/ links and share their confidential information, fraudsters steal their funds.

Here are some tips to stay safe from such fake offers:

- Never reveal sensitive information like Card number, CVV, Expiry date, Date of birth, OTP, etc. in any online links/ forms. Do not trust deals which are too good to be true.
- Never click on unknown links/ pop-up messages. Visit websites via genuine URL only .
- Do not share your personal details on public platforms/ social media as fraudsters may be tracing your data.
- Fraudsters aim to target people who are not too aware of mobile applications and technology. Hence be cautious of your interactions with strangers.
