

UIDAI- AADHAAR

Government of India has constituted **Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI)** on 28-01-2009 under the Planning Commission with the objective of issuing a **Unique Identification Number** called **A A D H A A R** to all the **Indian residents**

WHAT IS A A D H A A R?

- ✚ Aadhaar is a 12-digit unique number which the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) will issue for all residents.
- ✚ The number will be stored in a centralised database and linked to the basic demographics and biometric information

HOW TO GET AADHAAR?

Residents who intend to get the AADHAAR need to go to the nearest enrolment camp/ station to enrol themselves. The resident needs to carry certain documents relating to proof of identity {POI} and proof of address {POA}

Upon successful completion of enrolment, UIDAI will issue Aadhaar Number to the resident after de-duplication of data (i.e. after ensuring that no duplication of the enrolled data exists)

AADHAAR USAGE

- UID-Aadhaar Number identifies individuals uniquely on the basis of their demographic and biometric information and can help residents easily establish their identity to Banks and other Agencies.
- The Enrolment data sent by various Registrars and received by UIDAI can be used by banks for opening Bank accounts in bulk.
- Aadhaar Enabled Bank Accounts (AEBA) will be used for Direct Transfer of subsidies by Central and state Governments
- The centralised technology infrastructure of the UIDAI will enable 'anytime, anywhere, anyhow' authentication i.e. Agencies and service providers can contact

the Central Identities Data Repository [CIDR] of UIDAI from anywhere in the country to confirm a resident's/beneficiary's identity

Canara Bank is one of the **Registrars** for Aadhaar enrollment and the enrollment activity undertaken through UIDAI empanelled **Enrolling Agencies**

Pilot project on Aadhaar enrolment has been launched by our Bank at New Delhi on 29 03 2011 and subsequently in U.P, Maharastra, Kerala, Karnataka, Bihar, A.P and Rajasthan.

Pan-India enrolments will be undertaken shortly after finalizing the Enrolment Agencies .
